

## Town of Wilton Zoning Board of Adjustment

## **Notice of Decision**

On June 14, 1993, the Zoning Board of Adjustment of the Town of Wilton voted to grant a variance to James and Laura LaRue and to Forrest Hussey/ProCut, Inc. to permit the use of Lot L-027, Intervale Road, the site of the "Merit Tool Building", for an automobile and light truck repair business. (Case # 6/14/93-1)

Robert Landry, Margaret Landry, Helen Egan, Gill Hargrove, Natalie Hodgen, Arthur Hodgen, Paul Schlie, Robin Schlie, James Figlioli, Judy Figlioli, Daniel Ferguson, George Fox, Diane Fox, John Skelly, Elizabeth Skelly, and Paul English submitted a request that the Zoning Board reconsider its approval and rehear the application for a variance, as provided for by RSA 677:2.

In a public meeting on Thursday, July 15, 1993, the Zoning Board unanimously voted to affirm its original decision, and not to rehear the case.

The decision of the Zoning Board may be appealed within 30 days to the Superior Court, as specified in RSA 677:4.
