Notice is hereby given that the Town of Wilton Zoning Board of Adjustment will meet on Wednesday, June 8, 1994 at 7:30 pm in the Town Hall Courtroom to hold public hearings on the following applications:

Deborah L. and Marlon R. Greeley have applied for a special exception under the terms of Sections 6.6.1 and 5.3.6 of the Wilton Zoning Ordinance to allow a kindergarten/preschool in their home at Lot C-143, 126 Temple Road. (Case # 6/8/94-1)

Robert A. and Susan M. Blanchette have applied for a special exception under the terms of Section 5.3.7 of the Wilton Zoning Ordinance to allow a second dwelling unit in an existing home at Lot J-25, 40 Park Street. (Case # 6/8/94-2)

Jean MacKay (applicant) and Monadnock Community Land Trust (owner) have applied for a variance from the terms of Section 6.2.4 of the Wilton Zoning Ordinance to allow a the construction of a garage 14 feet from the lot line at Ms. MacKay's home at Lot A-39, Barrett Hill Road. (Case # 6/8/94-3)

Gould Leetch Trust (Riverview Mill) has applied for a special exception under the terms of Section 8.6.1 or a variance from the terms of Section 8.2.4(d) of the Wilton Zoning Ordinance to allow parking in the front setback area of the Riverview Mill Building, adjacent to Souhegan Street, on Lot K-168, Souhegan Street. (Case # 6/8/94-4)
