

## Town of Wilton Zoning Board of Adjustment

## Notice of Hearing

Notice is hearby given that the Town of Wilton Zoning Board of Adjustment will meet on Wednesday, July 10, 1996 at 7:30 pm in the Town Hall Courtroom to hold a public hearing on the following applications:

Michael G. Dell'Orto has applied for a variance from section 6.2.4 of the Wilton Zoning Ordinance, to permit the construction of a cordwood storage shed approximately fifteen feet from a lot line on Lot C-63, 21 Wilton Center Road. (Case #7/10/96-1)

The Wilton Center School, Inc. (applicant) and the Kaj-Aage Arends Revocable Trust (owner) have applied for a special exception under the terms of section 5.3.6 of the Wilton Zoning Ordinance to permit the establishment of an elementary school in an existing out-building on Lot C-64, 610 IsaacFrye Highway. (Case #7/10/96-2)

Alternatively, The Wilton Center School, Inc. (applicant) and the Unitarian Church First Congregational (owner) have applied for a special exception under the terms of section 5.3.6 of the Wilton Zoning Ordinance to permit the establishment of an elementary school in "The Unitarian Red House" on Lot C-75, Isaac Frye Highway. (Case #7/10/96-3)
