		<p>The installation was in progress for this tank. It is approximately 6 feet across. Installers, (employees at Einstein's), said it was a gray water system. Their boss (Mr. Langton) asked them to install it.</p>



This rectangular concrete hole in the ground is the current gray water system. This system is failing and laundry water is backing up into the house.

Instructions were to remove the pipe connecting to this old "tank" and hook it to the new one.

The code enforcement officer asked the two men to stop working and to not hook the system up.

The workers talked with the owner. They both assured the CEO that the pipe was not hooked to the new tank.
