Permission to construct, within the Town right-of-way, a driveway, entrance, exit, approach-adjointing Street/Road pursuant to the location and specifications as described below, is hereby granted. By submitting this driveway permit, you agree to construct said driveway in accordance with Section G: Driveway Regulations. **Failure to complete construction of said driveway within ONE CALENDAR YEAR of the date of this permit shall render permit null and void.** Any driveway constructed in violation of these conditions shall be corrected immediately upon notification by a Department representative, or the costs of removing said facility shall be fully borne by the owner. No structures, including buildings, permanent or portable signs, lights, displays, fences, walls, etc. shall be permitted on or under the highway right-of-way. (Mailboxes and house numbers for emergency services are exempt.)

1. This permit requires that the area adjacent to the highway be graded such that the surface will slope from the edge of pavement to a line 4 feet distance from and parallel to the pavement and 4 inches below the edge of pavement.

2. One (1) driveway entrance(s) is/are permissible. Driveway not to exceed 20 feet in width. The driveway entrance(s) may be flared as they approach the pavement. Width of pavement at edge of highway not to exceed 24 feet.

3. Potential accesses to the highway from the premises not permitted as driveways are to be blocked by construction of a barrier or barriers, such as a grass plot, low hedge, curbed island, etc. The front face of a barrier island shall be outside the right-of-way line. No part of the right-of-way may be used for any purpose other than travel.
