Please note that under current state law and regulations the Program is not authorized to consider local planning and zoning issues, which must be considered at the local level.

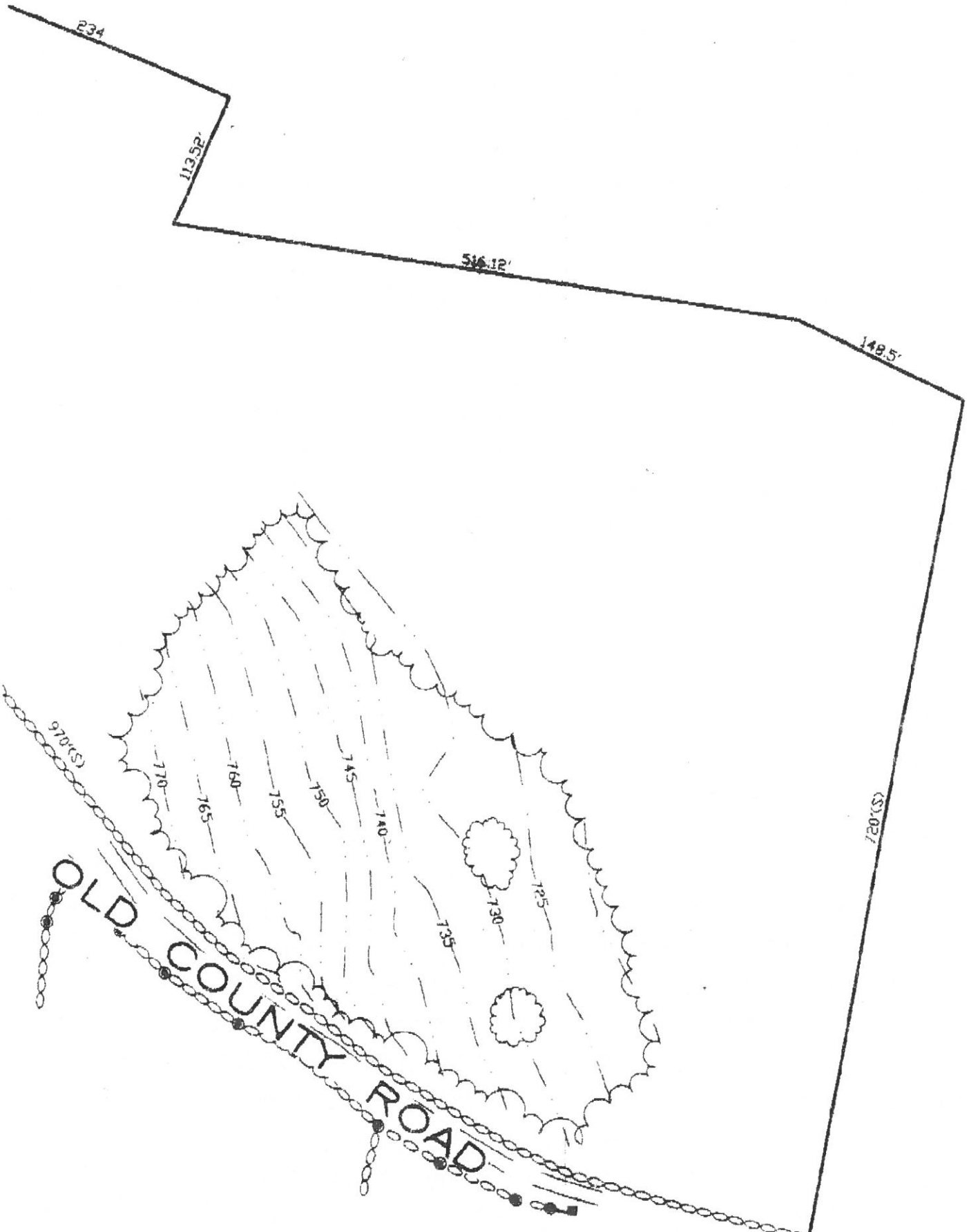

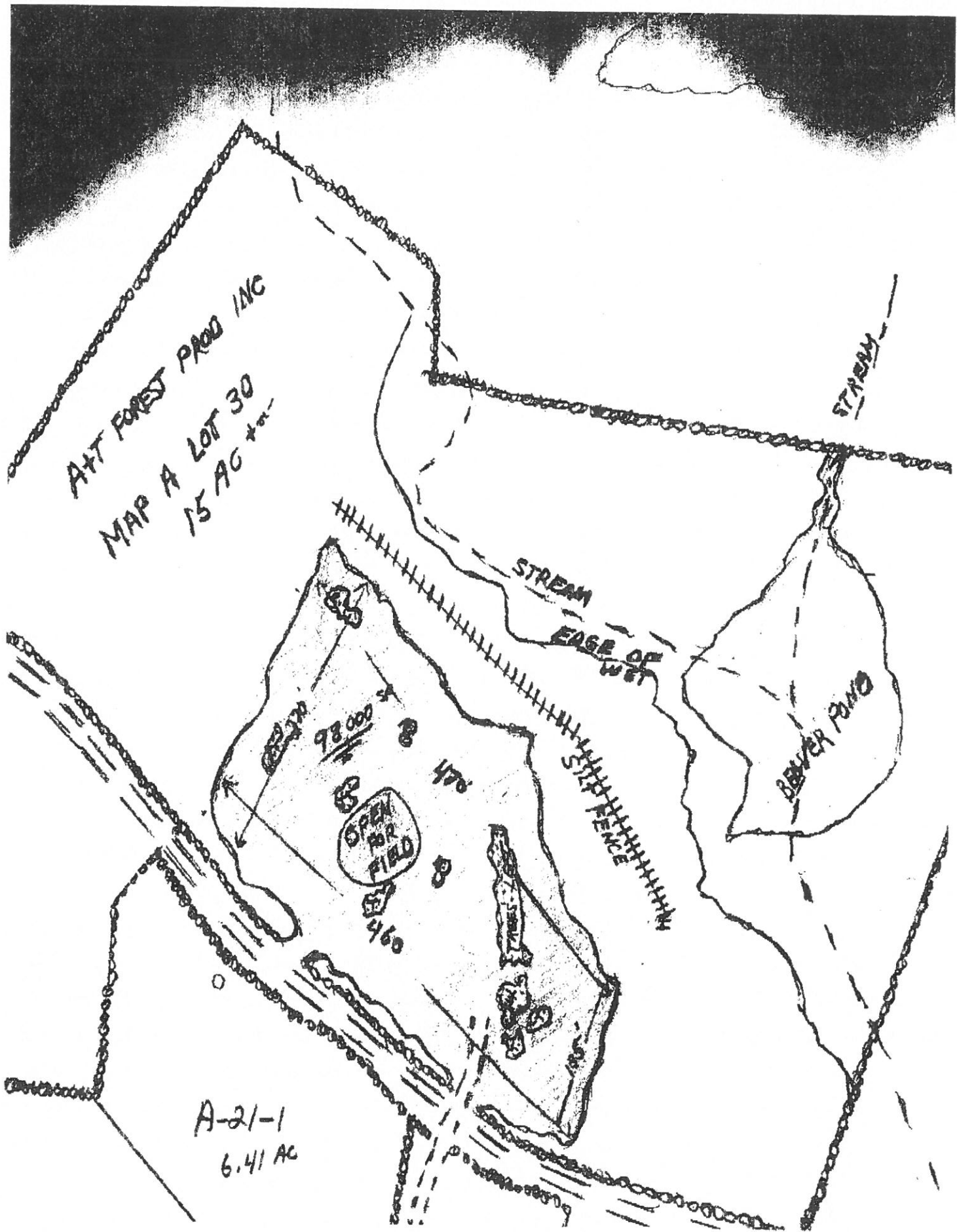

WETLANDS INSPECTION REPORT

A site inspection for compliance with RSA 422-A Wetlands ^{Ent} Permit # 2002-00291 was conducted at the following location on (date) 8/15/02

The following deficiencies were noted:

- Dredge/Fill/Construction exceeds permit limits
- Permit not posted
- Temporary erosion control measures not in place
- Other (Please see findings)
- Construction sequencing per plan is not being adhered to
- Water quality degradation is evident
- Construction is not in accordance with approved plan

Comments: The alleged site specific & wetland impacts were investigated with Mark Herbaugh (DES Legal Unit) and Jeff Ransom (AG's office)

Findings:

- ① There is no infractions to wetlands on Parcel A-21-2
- ② A small isolated wetland was observed within the confines of the "old spillway"
- ③ It was determined that the driveway from Burton Highway to the Old County Rd. complied w/ state standards.
- ④ It appears that some erosion/desertalization could occur in the future at the entrance of the road where logs have been used to secure the road's edge.
- ⑤ A very small wetland encroachment has occurred on the western side of Parcel A-30. Peter Schuver should be contacted ASAP to delineate this wetland. Brush & logging debris should be pulled immediately back (by 10/15/02)
