Meeting called to order 7:32 with all above present. Gail Proctor stated the nature of the application and the Ordinance involved, Article VIII, Section H-1.

Norman Stimson reviewed for the Board the past events which led to Mr. Robbins' application to the Board. Mr. Robbins is presently leasing the property from Rosemarie Tremblay with the option to purchase the property.
