Meeting called to order at 7:30 P.M. in the Selectmen's Room
with all the above present.

Gail Proctor stated the nature of the application and read the
ordinances involved.

The applicant briefly described the nature of the proposed
business and explained that she intends to make pierced lamp-
shades to sell in her shop and also sell the supplies to make
the product. She anticipated that the business would be only
opened a few days a week and she anticipated that the bulk of
the business would be by appointment. Mr. & Mrs. Tuttle ex-
plained that there would be ample parking in their driveway for
their clientele and off-street parking would not be necessary.
The shop would be located in an interior section of their pre-
sent home. The Board also reminded the apps. of the sign requmts.
The Board then reviewed the checklist and found that the pro-
posed use would meet all the criteria present in the Ordinances.

Motion proposed by Gail Proctor and seconded by Gary Crooker:

Be it resolved that the ZBA grant a Special Exception to
Ronald & Linda Tuttle under the terms of Article V, Section
B 1&2 of the Zoning Ordianance to operate a Lamp Shade Shop
at their Holt Road home.

There was no additional discussion.
The motion was voted on and passed unanimously.
